

DESCRIPTION OF THE INTERNSHIP

- The English Teaching Assistant will have a weekly work commitment from 20 to 30 hours in schools in Madrid and nearby area or Oviedo (North of Spain)
- Each English Teaching Assistant will be assigned a faculty advisor that will be in charge of helping the English Teaching Assistant organize his/her classes and of offering any teaching advice.
- The weekly work schedule should be organized from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. depending on individual needs of each school.
- Internships for one semester or full academic year, starting September or January and ending June. (Applicants for a Full Year Internship will have priority in the selection process)

PROFILE OF THE APPLICANT

Native English students graduated or last year students of these degrees:

- English or Spanish Studies
- Education of Teacher Training. Priority will be given to candidates with experience in training foreign languages.
- The applicants must come from a university in Canada, the United States, Australia, New Zealand, United Kingdom, Ireland or any other country with native English skills.

BENEFITS

- Monthly payment of 900€
- Access to the various resources (internet, photocopier, etc.) offered by the school.
- Some schools (boarding schools) might offer the teaching assistant room and board free of charge at the school residence.
- Assistance arranging the VISA, bank procedures, registration at Immigration and our Social Security Service.
